## FEDERAL ACQUISITION REGULATION (FAR) and DEFENSE FEDERAL ACQUISITION REGULATION SUPPLIEMENT (DFARS) FLOWDOWN CLAUSES

The following clauses as set forth in the FAR and DFARS effective on the date of this Purchase Order--unless otherwise indicated--are hereby incorporated by reference as if set forth in full. Note, the terms "Government" and "Contracting Officer" do not change: (1) when a right, act, authorization or obligation can be granted or performed only by the Government or the Contracting Officer or duly authorized representative; (2) when title to property is to be transferred directly to the Government; and (3) in FAR 52.227-1, 52.227-2, and DFARS 252.227-7013 and 252.227-7014

By accepting this Purchase Order Seller represents and certifies to the best of its knowledge and belief, that the Seller and/or any of its principals: are not presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, or declared ineligible for the award of contracts by any Federal agency; have not, within a three-year period preceding this offer, been convicted of or had a civil judgment rendered against them for: commission of fraud or a criminal offense in connection with obtaining, attempting to obtain, or performing a public (Federal, State, or local) contract or subcontract; violation of Federal or State antitrust statutes relating to the submission of offers; or commission of embezzlement, theft, forgery, bribery, falsification or destruction of records, making false statements, tax evasion, violating Federal criminal tax laws, or receiving stolen property; are not presently indicted for, or otherwise criminally or civilly charged by a governmental entity with, commission of any of the offenses enumerated in the preceding clause; have not, within a threeyear period preceding this offer, been notified of any delinquent Federal taxes in an amount that exceeds the threshold at 9.104-5(a)(2) for which the liability remains unsatisfied; and has not, within a three-year period preceding this Purchase Order, had one or more contracts terminated for default by any Federal agency.
